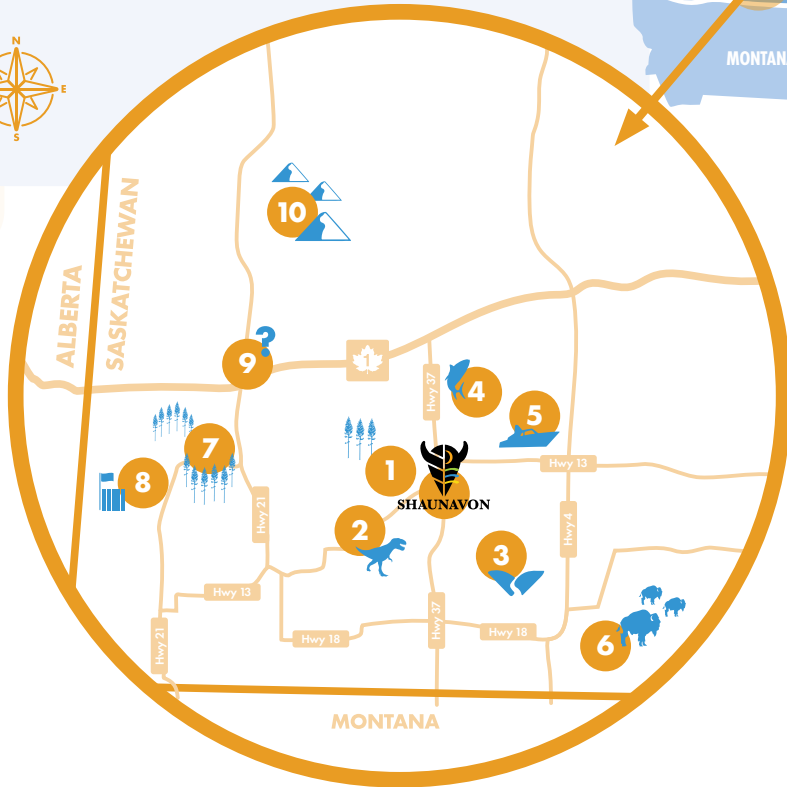

Adventure through the Southwest!

Centrally located between Cypress Hills Interprovincial Park and Grasslands National Park, Shaunavon offers *easy access to the region's top attractions!*



1 PINE CREE REGIONAL PARK: This scenic park is beyond your wildest expectations! Come picnic or camp and enjoy a range of activities including bird watching, fishing, cycling and hiking. With the Swift Current Creek running through, this natural park offers pine and poplar trees, sand caves and numerous hiking trails. You won't forget your stay here!
Location: Approximately 32 km west of Shaunavon off of Highway 13



2 T.REX DISCOVERY CENTRE: Operated by the Royal Saskatchewan Museum, Scotty, Saskatchewan's most massive Tyrannosaurus rex, dominates the center gallery. The Museum features hands-on learning activities, children's activities, prehistoric mammal galleries, a 98-seat theatre, fossil lab and natural history-themed gift shop.
Location: 33 km west of Shaunavon



3 FRENCHMAN RIVER VALLEY: Take a scenic drive off the beaten path through the Frenchman River Valley to witness the beauty of glacier-carved ravines and the layered hills of the badlands. From the Cypress Hills, it loops its way down to Eastend. After passing through Grasslands National Park, it eventually joins the Milk River in northeastern Montana.
Location: Approximately 44 km south of Shaunavon



4 DUNCAIRN DAM: This area was originally created as an irrigation project for the PFRA. Over the years it has developed into a major recreation area. If camping, fishing, water skiing or just relaxing is something you are interested in, you are in the right area.
Location: Approximately 44 km northeast of Shaunavon



5 LAC PELLETIER REGIONAL PARK: A small spring-fed lake surrounded by trees and cabins, this lake is a great place for camping, boating, swimming and fishing. You will also find a beautiful golf course featuring stunning lake views, and many other amenities including beaches, a mini golf course and more!
Location: Approximately 77 km northeast of Shaunavon



6 GRASSLANDS NATIONAL PARK: Established in 1981, Grasslands National Park preserves one of Canada's few remaining areas of mixed-grass prairie. Spanning over 900 square kilometers, the park is divided into East and West Blocks, with the West Block accessible near Val Marie. Home to diverse wildlife, including bison, pronghorns, and black-tailed prairie dogs. The park also offers some of Canada's darkest night skies, making it ideal for stargazing.
Location: Approximately 120 km southeast of Shaunavon



7 CYPRESS HILLS INTERPROVINCIAL PARK (SK): Cypress Hills Interprovincial Park spans the Alberta-Saskatchewan border, offering diverse landscapes of towering hills, lush forests, and prairies. Visitors can enjoy a variety of activities, including camping, hiking, and stargazing in one of Canada's largest Dark Sky Preserves.
Location: Approximately 122 km west of Shaunavon



8 FORT WALSH NATIONAL HISTORIC PARK: Fort Walsh National Historic Site offers visitors an immersive experience of a reconstructed 1870s North-West Mounted Police fort. The site provides valuable insights into the events surrounding the Cypress Hills Massacre and its profound impact on the Nakoda people and the region's history.
Location: Approximately 122 km west of Shaunavon



9 SOUTHWEST SASKATCHEWAN VISITOR CENTRE: Located on Highway 1 North of Maple Creek, the Southwest Saskatchewan Tourism & Investment Attraction Hub is the spot to gather information on attractions and events, and visiting or relocating to the Southwest region of Saskatchewan.
Location: Approximately 122 km northwest of Shaunavon



10 GREAT SANDHILLS: The Great Sandhills are a unique phenomenon to this area of Southwest Saskatchewan. The large mass of sand and dunes cover 1,900 square kilometres and are subject to very strong winds, creating an ever-changing landscape. Some of the dunes stand 15 to 20 metres high, and cover several hectares of land.
Location: Approximately 170 km northwest of Shaunavon

HERITAGE WALKING TOUR

Heritage Highlights

The Shaunavon Court House, now home to the Town Office, was constructed in 1926 by Smith and Wilson of Regina under Provincial Architect Maurice W. Sharon, at a cost of \$42,500.

One of five identical courthouses built in Saskatchewan, this impressive two-storey brick building features Ruf-Tex brick from Claybank, a pitched roof with an ornate cupola, and detailed wood and copper accents. Inside, many original elements remain, including terrazzo floors and woodwork, reflecting its historic role as a centre for justice and administration. Converted into Town Office space in 1958, the building has been carefully maintained and was

designated a Municipal Heritage Property in 1984. The surrounding grounds, originally landscaped with trees, hedges, and flower beds, continue to enhance its stately presence along 3rd Street East.

This iconic building is celebrating its 100-year anniversary!

The Plaza Theatre & Venue

The Plaza Theatre has been a cornerstone of Shaunavon's story for nearly a century. Built in 1927 by contractor Edward "Ted" Strickland for Lewis (Charley) and Lily Durham, it first opened as a lively dance pavilion: its hardwood floors filled with music, movement, and community spirit. In 1930, it transformed into a "talkie" movie house under Famous Players, welcoming audiences into the magic of film with seating for 640. With its signature lime green interior, hand-painted posters, and the glowing marquee added in 1946, the Plaza quickly became a beloved gathering place with a front row seat to life on Centre Street.

For generations, the Durham family cared for the theatre and kept its spirit alive, with Herb and Leslie Goldstein (Leslie being the granddaughter of the original owners) serving as its most recent stewards before passing the torch.

Today, that legacy has transitioned to a new family: Ty and Lizzy Hunter, who already had a deep connection to the Plaza's story through operating Meeting Grounds Coffee House within the building since 2020. They now bring a revived energy to the Plaza Theatre & Venue while honouring all that came before. The Plaza is like a slice of New York in a small town, where the space welcomes live performances, concerts, and Broadway-style productions, while continuing the classic movie experience, complete with the legacy of the Plaza's famous popcorn.

With its iconic marquee lighting up Centre Street, the Plaza remains a place for community and connection: a space to escape, to be entertained, and to gather, just as it has been for generations.

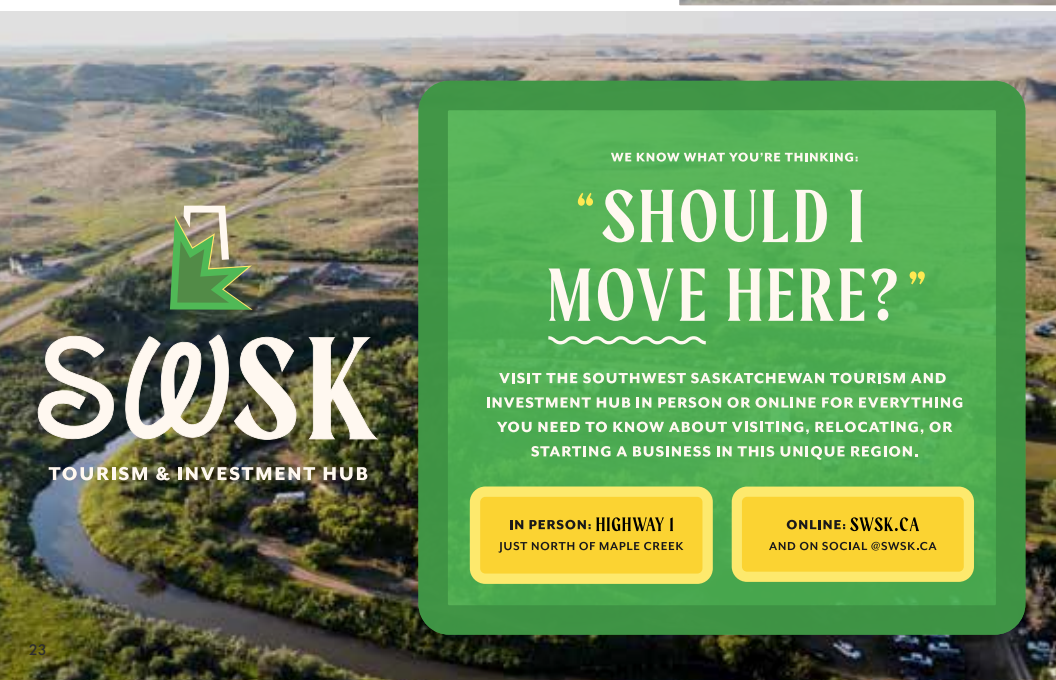
